Matenco AB's commitments

- is to ensure that we are compliance with Dodd-Frank Consumer Protection section 1502 about Conflict Minerals.
- is that the products it sells do not incorporate "conflict minerals," smelted into tin, tantalum, tungsten and gold sourced from entities which directly or indirectly finance conflict in the Democratic Republic of Congo or adjoining countries.
- is in addition, we are committed to engaging with our customers regarding their disclosure obligations.

Matenco AB's statment

Matenco AB will work towards these following number of steps that include:

- requiring our suppliers to implement a policy regarding Conflict Minerals and exercise due diligence to investigate the source of these minerals.
- engaging with our suppliers so that they respond in a timely manner to our requests for evidence of compliance. In the future, our suppliers' willingness to comply with this initiative will be a factor in our sourcing decisions.
- updating the Matenco AB purchasing terms and conditions to reflect this policy.
- suppliers commitment to being or becoming "conflict-free," so that any such metals are sourced only from conflict-free smelters.
